

Photoshop users can use this PDF as a design template by rasterizing it in CMYK mode at 300ppi.

- Make sure your design extends to the outside edge of the Bleed Area to avoid white borders around your print.
- The trim line indicates the edge of your final print.
- To avoid any essential items being cut off, keep text and critical design elements inside the Safety Area.

BACK PANEL
 12.25" x 12.37"
 (add 0.20 " on top, bottom and left side for art bleed)

FRONT PANEL
 12.25" x 12.37"
 (add 0.20 " on top, bottom and right side for art bleed)

SPINE AREA
 0.16" x 12.62"
 ← Spine text should face the left side and should not be bigger than 0.15 inches.

Extend all artwork to the bleed line.
 Pink solid line is the cut line; this is where the art will be cut.
 Green line is the safety margin; keep all text and important elements within this line.
 Please make sure all artwork is CMYK.
